### 1. FISHATHON 1.0

The accepted ideas will be presented as prototypes/working models during the live pitch. The winners will get the opportunity to launch their startups with the support of Fisheries and Aquaculture Investors.

### 2. POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Abstracts are invited on the above thematic areas for poster presentations. Submission of abstracts for poster presentations should follow the guidelines.

### **Awards**

The best presentations in each session will be awarded.

### WHO CAN APPLY

The conference is open to young fisheries graduates from various Fisheries Colleges / Institutes across India. All undergraduates and postgraduate students nominated as individual or team (minimum 2 and maximum 10) by their respective Fisheries Colleges / Institutes are invited to participate in the event.

#### **GUIDELINES**

#### Abstract Submission

Abstracts for FISHATHON 1.0 and Poster Presentations shall be submitted within the thematic area given in brochure.

Abstract should not exceed 150 words. The abstract should succinctly describe the project, including the problem statement, the solution or prototype, key features, and the expected impact. Submit the abstract in a Word document.

### **Prototype/Working Model Presentation**

Ensure that your prototype or working model is functional and well-tested before the event. Bring all necessary materials for the setup, including power sources, cables, and other equipment. Follow any size or space limitations provided for displaying prototypes or working models. Be prepared to give a live demonstration of your prototype during the event. Explain its working mechanism, key features, and potential use cases.

#### **Poster Presentation**

The poster size will be intimated during acceptance of abstract. Poster shall include clear and concise title of your project, brief background information on the problem you are addressing, key outcomes or findings from your project, key takeaways, impact, and potential future work. Use high-quality visuals (diagrams, graphs, and images) to support your points. Ensure the poster is visually appealing and well-organized.
