#### VACANCY ANNOUNEMENT

The Department of Fisheries Biology and Resource Management of Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi invites application for TWO JRF posts under the following two Institute - Industry partnership projects funded by the Crab Meat Processors Association (CMPA), Thoothukudi.

- Assessment of Portunus pelagicus stock based on length-frequency, length based spawning potential ratio, size at first maturity and occurrence of berried female caught in bottom set gillnet from Palk Bay region
- 2. Assessment of biodiversity and biomass of non-target fish species caught in bottom set gillnet fishery targeting blue swimming crab in Palk Bay region

The projects will be operated in the Dept. of Fisheries Biology and Resource Management, Fisheries College and Research Institute, Tamil Nadu Dr. J. Jayalalithaa Fisheries University for a period of one year (July 2025 – July 2026)

- 2. The appointee will be governed by the regulations & rules which are in force in the university for the contractual engagement of manpower

- allowed to appear in the interview unless he/ she sends duly filled-in prescribed application form to the said email.
- 4. All applications received after the mentioned time limit will be summarily rejected. Shortlisted eligible candidates will be invited for personal interview through email.
- 5. The last date is the cut-off date for all purposes including Age/ Qualification/ Experience etc.
- Unless a candidate sends Certificate/Provisional Certificate in respect of Graduation & Post Graduation Qualification, his/her application will be summarily rejected.
- 7. The Principal Investigator (PI) of the project will have full discretion to fix separate minimum criteria for shortlisting and criteria for interview for each category of candidates.
- 8. The prescribed essential qualifications are minimum requirements and the mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview. If the number of applications received in response to advertisement are large, it will not be convenient or possible to call all candidates for interview. Accordingly, Principal Investigator (PI) of the project may restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable limit of desirable qualification and / or on the record of academic performance and / or relevant experience for the post prescribed in the advertisement as per the specific requirement of the project and /or any other bench mark decided by a committee constituted to screen the applications. The final selection of the candidate will be based on the candidate's performance in the Interview and based on the selection committee's recommendations. No correspondence will be entertained with candidates who are not called for Interview / not selected for appointment.
- 9. Canvassing in any form and / or bringing any influence, political or

- otherwise will be treated as disqualification of candidature. No interim correspondence / inquiry will be entertained.
- 10. No TA/DA shall be provided for appearing for the interview or for joining at the specified place
- 11. The places of posting indicated above are provisional and liable to change subject to the need and essentiality in the scheme work
- 12. The job involves halting during visit to fish landing centres / fishing harbours along the Palk bay region. The selected candidates may be required to travel in the sea for sample collection.
- 13. Selected candidate (s) will be required to produce all original documents at the time of interview.
- 14. Any amendment in the notification will be published only in the website
- 15. The selected candidates shall have no right/claim for regular appointment at TNJFU at any point of time. Further, no claim for continuance or switching over to any other vacant post is possible
- 16. The appointing authority reserves the right to defer the filling of above positions now announced without assigning any reasons there for
- 17. Selected candidates may have to join the post immediately
- 18. The Dean's decision will be final and binding on all aspects.
