
In this virtual meeting farmers, Youth, Entrepreneurs from all over Tamil Nadu have taken active participation during the entire course of the meeting.

Fish farmers of Chengalpattu and Tiruvallur districts were present on this occasion, Dr. N. Felix, Director distributed Growpia feed manufactured at DIVA feed mill unit to the farmers.





#### Harvest of Pacific white shrimp

Nursery rearing of *Penaeus vannamei* post larvae were carried outin Directorate of Incubation and Vocational training in Aquaculture (DIVA), ECR-Muttukadu, Chennai in cement tanks (24 m³). Initially, 6000 PL were stocked and at the end of nursery rearing, 88% survival rate was achieved. *P.vannamei* grow-out culture was carried out in a lined pond (150m²) for 90 days. Dr. N. Felix, Director, commenced the harvesting of shrimps and 55 kg of shrimps were harvested with 83% survival rate.


#### Sadbhavan Diwas Day - Pledge


## Online Training Programme on "Farm Made Fish Feed Preparation"
