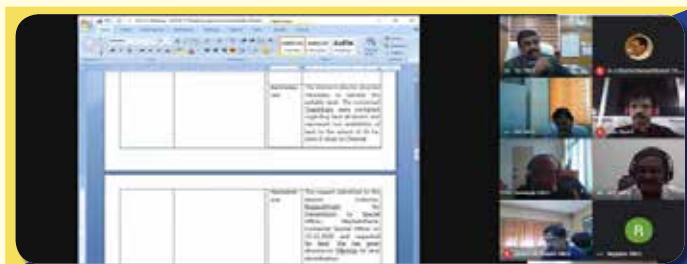

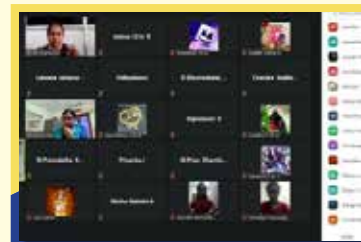

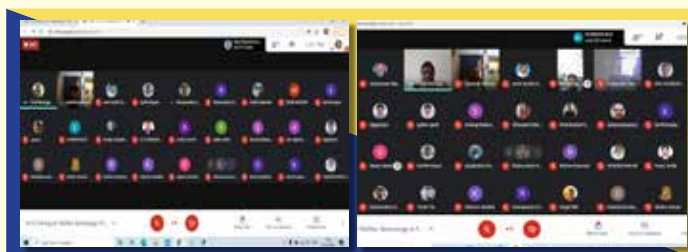

### Tree Plantation

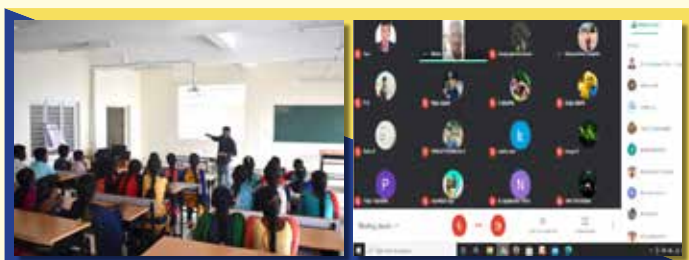
Tree plantation was carried out in the college premises and 75 nos of tree saplings were planted around the college campus on 24.12.2020.

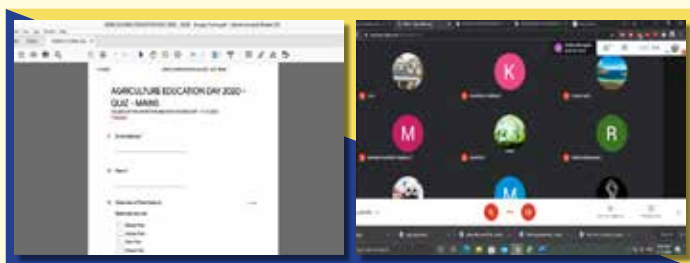

#### Agricultural Education Day 2020

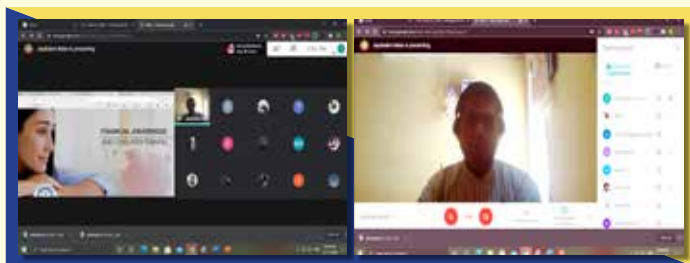

### Directorate of Incubation and Vocational training in Aquaculture (DIVA), Muttukadu: "Shrimp harvest day" observed

Pacific white shrimp, *Penaeus vannamei*, were harvested in the indoor aquaculture complex, DIVA on 17.12.2020. Shrimp post-larvae were procured from Raj hatchery for the industry-institute project, nursery reared and cultured in cement tanks (24m<sup>3</sup> volume) for 120 days. Survival was estimated to be 90% with an average size of 30 g. Dr. N. Felix, Director, launched the harvest, and about 32 kg of shrimps were harvested and sold.
